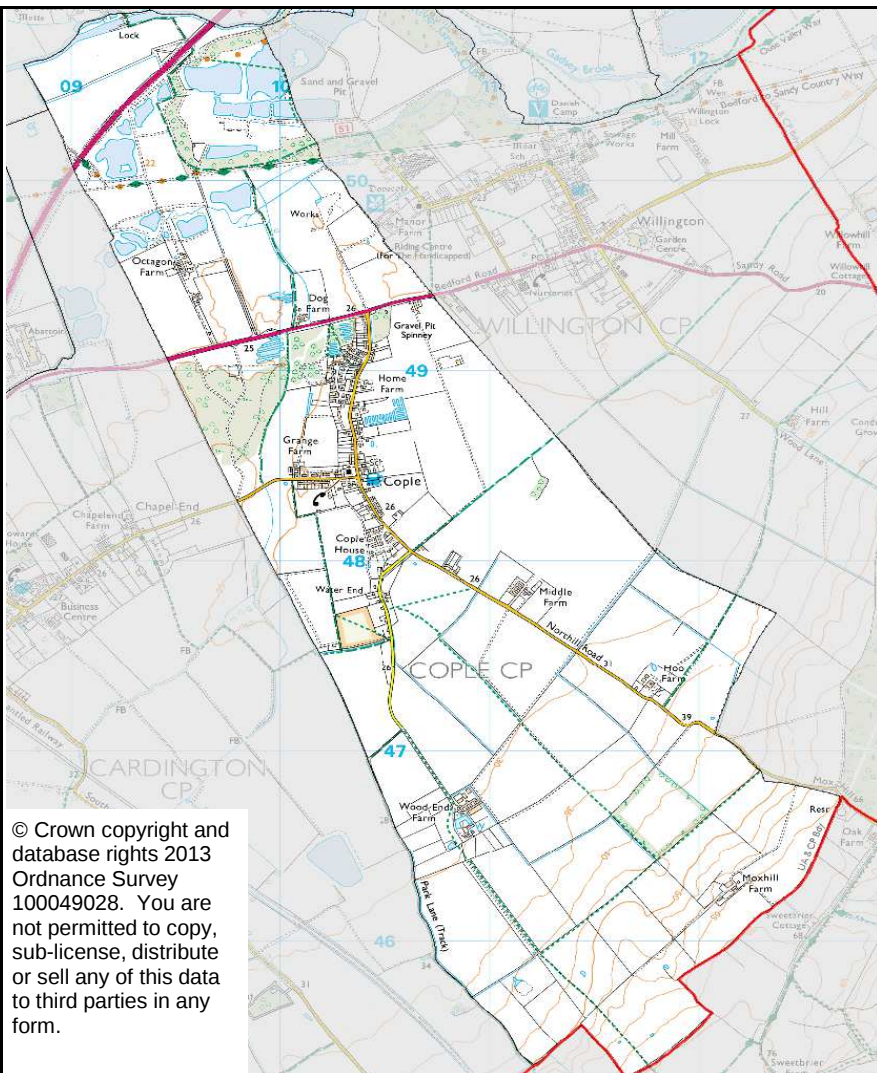

Located in the south east of Bedford Borough, Cople has an older age profile than the Borough with a high proportion of residents aged 40-64 and 20% aged over 65. A quarter of all households are pensioners and non-White British residents form 6% of the total population.

There is a high proportion of one-person households (28%), evenly divided between pensioners and non-pensioners. Home ownership (76%) is high, with 14% of households renting from social landlords and 10% renting privately. Housing is primarily detached (37%) and semi-detached (38%).

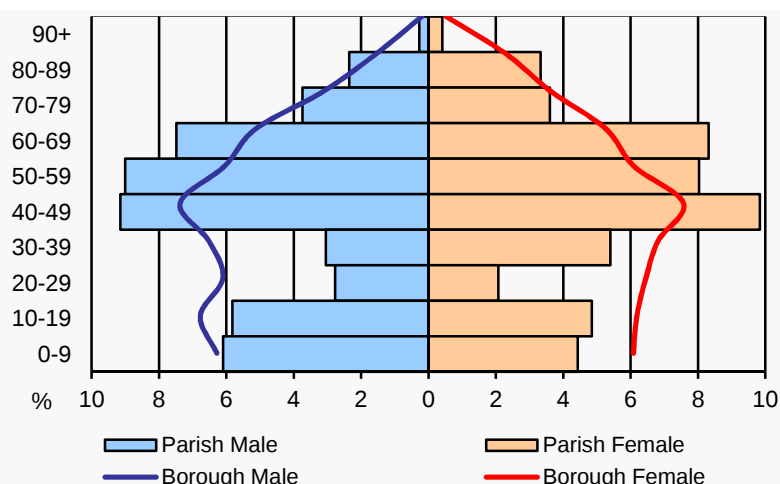
Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (41%) is very high. 13% of those in employment are self-employed, 10% work from home, and 11% work in skilled trades.

The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (34%) matches the average for rural parishes, and 18% have no qualifications. Most households (75%) use gas central heating. Health of residents and the provision of unpaid care are both similar to the Borough average.

The level of households without a car (13%) exceeds the average for all parishes, though 40% of households have 2 cars, and 16% have 3 or more. Levels of commuting by train (4%) are low, most people (80%) travel to work by car, and only 3% of those in employment cycle or walk to work.
